I. Paul's 2nd Visit to Jerusalem vv. 1-2

- A. It corresponds with Acts 11:27-30
- B. It is called "the famine visit"
- C. Paul went there to discuss the gospel
- D. Paul went there in response to a revelation

II. The Outcome of the 2nd Visit vv. 3-10

- A. Titus was not compelled to be circumcised
- B. All this was prompted by the Judaizers
- C. Paul refused to compromise
- D. The other apostles added nothing to Paul
- E. They agreed on a division of labor
- Paul to the Gentiles, Peter to the Jews
- F. The other apostles affirmed Paul
- G. They asked Paul to remember the poor

Conclusion: the gospel of "alone" is the only gospel
