  - D. He is a liar, deceiver, murderer John 8:44
- IV. The Sinful Choice and Consequences vv. 6-11
  - A. The tree (situation) looked good to Eve
  - B. She ate and gave to her husband- 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy 2:14
  - C. Their eyes were opened and they felt shame
  - D. They tried to cover up and hide
