- 4. No more crying
- 5. No more pain

A. Eve (English), Kavah (Hebrew)

B. 1st Corinthians 15:22; Romans 5:12

III. The Death of Animals for Adam and Eve v. 21

A. Adam and Eve should have died, not animals

B. Adam and Eve had never seen death

C. This was the first shedding of blood

IV. The Banishment from the Garden vv. 22-24

A. This was an act of compassion

- B. This was decided by the triune God "Us"
- C. Adam was reminded of the cursed ground
- D. Cherubim were stationed as armed guards * Ezekiel 1:1-14
