 - B. Luke begins the story a year into the ministry
- II. The Visit to the Nazareth Synagogue vv. 16-30
 - A. Jesus read from Isaiah 61:1-2
 - 1. He stopped in the middle of verse 2
 - 2. He claimed this passage was about Him
 - 3. The people were conflicted
 - B. Jesus rebuked the people of Nazareth
 - 1. They wanted Him to do some "tricks"
 - 2. Jesus would not comply
 - 3. He knew they wouldn't accept Him
 - C. Jesus gave examples of Gentile salvation
 - 1. From the ministry of Elijah
 - 2. From the ministry of Elisha
 - D. The people were enraged and tried to kill Him John 7:30, 44; 8:20, 59; 10:39; Matt. 26:5
