Introduction: Jesus had to be crucified

- He was delivered up by Pilate (Luke 23:25) and by God (Rom. 8:32)
- His crucifixion fulfilled prophecy Ps. 22; John 3:14-15; 12:32-33
- I. The Carrying of the Cross of Jesus v. 26
 - A. Jesus was led away to be crucified Isa. 53:7
 - B. His cross was carried by Simon of Cyrene
 - C. Simon's wife & son became believers Romans 16:13
- II. The People Who Followed Along vv. 27-31
 - A. "A great multitude followed Him"
 - B. The daughters of Jerusalem were warned about Jerusalem's destruction in A.D. 70
- III. The Crucifixion of Jesus vv. 32-33
 - A. There were two others crucified and Jesus was in the middle
 - B. It took place on Calvary (Golgotha)
 - C. Isaiah prophesied this in 53:12
