 - B. Jesus appeared to them
 - C. The disciples thought it was a ghost/spirit John 12:27
- III. The Resurrection Proof Jesus Gave vv. 40-43
 - A. He showed them His hands and feet
 - B. He ate food in their presence Acts 10:41
