I. Paul's Journey Back to Jerusalem

- -Luke joins the team
- -Paul's impact in Tyre

II. Paul's Determination Despite the Hesitations

- -Whenever the risks outweighed the benefits, Paul left
- -Whenever the benefits outweighed the risks, Paul pressed on
- -The benefits of going to Jerusalem:
 - 1.) To give money to meed needs.
 - 2.) To bring unity between Jew and Gentile believers.

III. Paul's Humility Despite the Accusations

- -Paul's humility in his missionary report
- -False rumors about Paul's ministry
- -Paul's willingness to participate in the Nazirite vow
- -"As believers, we do what we know is right out of a motivation to honor God, not with the expectation that things will get better."
- -3 keys to avoiding false assumptions in relationships:
 - 1.) If you have a concern, believe the best.
 - 2.) If you have reason to doubt the best, talk to the person.
 - 3.) If you decide to talk to the person, do so in a humble-& gentle-fashion.
