- -4 previous snapshots of God's sovereignty:
 - 1.) God is sovereign, even when I suffer.
 - 2.) God is sovereign, even when it seems too late.
 - 3.) God is sovereign, even when my faith is weak.
 - 4.) God is sovereign, even when the wicked seem to prosper.
- II. 4 More Snapshots of God's Sovereignty:
- 5.) God is sovereign, even when I make mistakes
 - -Paul wasn't perfect; he made mistakes
 - -Romans 7:15
 - -This was probably a major blow of discouragement
 - -The Lord encouraged Paul
- 6.) God is sovereign, even when I'm not aware of it
 - -The plot against Paul
 - -There is no way to explain this scenario except for God's providence
 - -Similar to the book of Esther
- 7.) God is sovereign, even when I feel alone
 - -How many present were against Paul?
 - -How many present were for Paul?
 - -Even though Paul was alone, the Lord was with him
- 8.) God is sovereign, even when life doesn't make sense
 - -2 Corinthians 12

Principle #1 - God humbles His children by means of suffering.

Principle #2 - God is ultimately the one to whom we can go in our suffering.

Principle #3 - God's solution is often to increase grace.

Principle #4 - God perfects power out of weakness.
