  - 5.) God is sovereign, even when I make mistakes.
  - 6.) God is sovereign, even when I'm not aware of it.
  - 7.) God is sovereign, even when I feel alone.

## 3 More Snapshots of God's Sovereignty:

- 9.) God is sovereign, even when I'm mistreated.
  - -Paul's constant battle with false accusations
  - -God is at work, even when we are mistreated
  - -Example: Joseph
- 10.) God is sovereign, even in the monotony of life.
  - -God is in control, even when life seems so repetitive
  - -Paul remained faithful to the Lord despite his ongoing appearances in court
- 11.) God is sovereign, even when His ways are not ours.
  - -God promised that Paul would bring the gospel to Rome back in chapter 23
  - -The fulfillment of this promise didn't take place until the end of chapter 26
  - -When Paul left for Rome, he left as a prisoner
  - -God is in control, even when things don't work out the way we think
