# II. The Principle of Friendship Demonstrated

-Luke and Aristarchus accompanied Paul

- -2 possible reasons for their being allowed to do this:
  - 1.) The centurion was informed that Paul was innocent
  - 2.) The two men would have accompanied Paul as slaves

#### III. The Possession of Integrity Realized

-In a short time, Paul had earned a reputation of trust

-In a short time, Paul's character had influenced the centurion

-All of us should be like Paul in that way

#### IV. The Power of Initiative Taken

-When Paul recognized there was a problem, he took the initiative to help

- -All of us should be initiators in some way or another
  - 1.) We should be initiators in meeting needs
  - 2.) We should be initiators in growing spiritually

# V. The Practice of Faith Manifested

- -Paul believed that God knew what He was doing
- -God didn't keep Paul from the storm
