Two Ingredients for Effective Spiritual Growth

I. Spiritual Growth involves Diligent Effort (v.12)

- 1 Cor. 9:27 "I discipline my body"
- 1 Tim. 4:7 "Exercise yourself toward godliness"
- "...not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence"
- Prov. 27:17

II. Spiritual Growth involves Divine Energy (v. 13)

- Spiritual growth involves us working it out and God working within
- John 15:5 "apart from Me, you can do nothing"
- John MacArthur: "The truth is that spiritual growth is God's work, but He performs is through the diligent self-discipline and righteous pursuits of His people, not in spite of them. God's sovereign work does not absolve (or excuse) believers from the need for obedience; it means their obedience is itself a Spirit-empowered work of God."
