- The parable of the soils Matthew 13:3-9; 18-23
- The example of Judas John 6:67-69; Matthew 10:1-7
- 1 Cor. 15:1-2
- Col. 1:21-23
- Eternal security: If the salvation is real, then it is eternal
- <u>Perseverance of faith</u>: If the salvation is real, then it will continue
