"Even laws of thought and methods, along with factual evidence, will be accepted and evaluated in light of one's governing presuppositions... All chains of argumentation, especially over matters of ultimate personal importance, trace back to and depend upon starting points which are taken to be self-evidencing..." (*Always Ready*, by Greg Bahnsen, Ed. by Robert R. Booth, p 77)

Both Christians and non-Christians evaluate and define life based on the convictions of their ______ which are accepted by faith. We call those "presuppositions." Solomon reflected this:

Prov 4:23 - "Watch over your heart with all diligence, for from it flow the springs of life." James illustrates how these basic convictions/presuppositions ______ what we do, say, and think.

Jas 3:11–12 - "11 Does a fountain send out from the same opening both fresh and bitter water? 12 Can a fig tree, my brethren, produce olives, or a vine produce figs? Nor can salt water produce fresh."

Jesus demonstrates presuppositional convictions - the Rich Man and Lazarus in Lk 16:19-31.

"**29** "But Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.' "**30** "But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' "**31** "But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead.' ""

It was unbelief not ______ that was the key.

Colossians 2:3-8 - "**2** Christ... **3** in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. **4** I say this so that no one will delude you with persuasive argument. **5** For even though I am absent in body, nevertheless I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good discipline and the stability of your faith in Christ. **6** Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, **7** having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude. **8** See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, rather than according to Christ."

"2 Christ... 3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge."

"Speculations" are ideas, theories, and concepts based on "_____ reasoning," or ones "imagination."

"Speculations" include "every lofty thing," every proud or self-righteous philosophy designed to suppress and discredit the ______ of God.

B. Don't Be ______ With Persuasive Argument – vs. 4-5

"4 I say this so that no one will delude you with persuasive argument. 5 For even though I am absent in body, nevertheless I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good discipline and the stability of your faith in Christ."

"persuasive argument"

One reason we are deceived and have no countering argument is because we measure these arguments using ______ yardstick.

C. Walk in Him – vs 6-7

"6 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him"

"walk in Him." Cp. **Eph 4:1 -** "Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to <u>walk</u> in a manner worthy of the calling ..."

To "walk in Him," means that our counseling definitions and ______ are to be rooted and grounded in His "wisdom and knowledge."

"7 having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed..."

That means in counseling our definitions and methods need to ______ out of and be consistent with the Word of God. It is the application of God's truth to these aspects of our counseling that "______" roots us in Scripture and distinguishes it as Christian counseling, and enables us to help our counselees to be "built up in Him and ______" in their faith.

Do not miss the unbroken ______ connecting our being rooted, built up, and established in Christ to instruction in the Word of God.

D. Do Not Be Deceived - vs 8

"**8** See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, <u>rather</u> than according to Christ."

Two origins:

1. "according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world"

"philosophy" - is any theory about God and life that is not according to God's word.

"Empty deception" any thinking that is in opposition of God's word. (*Always Ready*, by Greg Bahnsen, Ed. by Robert R. Booth, p 12)

Compare the secular psychological and psychiatric communities' offer today.

Eph 4:17–18 "17 ... walk, in the futility of their mind...18 being darkened in their understanding

Their approach is meant to bring glory to ______ as they revel in their rebellion against God. Our calling is to "destroy(ing) speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God...taking every ______ captive to the obedience of Christ," **2 Co 10:5**

Might we have that kind of confidence and allegiance to God and His Word.

A. CHRIST Is The Source – Col. 3:2-3

I.e To define...person as "co-dependency" lacks <u>SPIRITUAL</u> understanding...relationship to <u>GOD</u> Every piece of fruit on a tree will be affected by the <u>ROOTS</u> from which it grows, Paul understood that we are in a **WAR** for men's hearts - **2 Co 10:3–5**

"Speculations" are...based on "FALSE reasoning,"

"Speculations" include... discredit the KNOWLEDGE of God.

B. Don't Be **DELUDED** With Persuasive Argument – Col. 3:4-5

One reason...arguments using **THEIR** yardstick... God's yardstick – the **WORD** of God. **I.e.** ...Carl Roger's belief in the inherent **GOODNESS** of man.

C. Walk in Him – **Col. 3:6-7**

"received" carries connotations of "something which was delivered by TRADITION."

To "walk in Him," means our counseling definitions and METHODS are to be rooted

That means...need to GROW out...counseling that "FIRMLY" 7 roots us...and ESTABLISHED" in

Do not miss the unbroken CHAIN connecting our being rooted

D. Do Not Be Deceived - Col. 3:8

Their approach...bring glory to MAN...their rebellion...taking every THOUGHT captive... 2 Co 10:5

The only other source of ideas is that which is "according to **CHRIST**" 8.

These two sources of thought are **<u>ANTITHETICAL</u>** to and exclusionary of one another.
