- Gentiles replace the Jews as the focus

 - 2. Teachers Ephesians 4:11-12
- B. The specific men
 - 1. Barnabas Acts 4, 11
 - 2. Simeon called Niger
 - 3. Lucias of Cyrene
 - 4. Manaen
 - 5. Saul

II. "As they ministered to the Lord and fasted..." v. 2

- A. Ministry is to the Lord Colossians 3:23
- B. Fasting
 - 1. Matthew 6:16-18, 9:14-15
 - 2. The example of Jesus
 - 3. The example of the elders Acts 14:23

III. "... they sent them away." v. 3

- A. They were already involved in ministry at home
- B. They were from a strong church
