The Greatness of the Calling

2 Corinthians 5:14-21 Missions Conference 2017

Introduction: The Supremacy of Christ in His sufferings and death. - 2 Corinthians 4:5-15, 6:4-10, 1:3-11

- 1. The *Love* of Christ compels us (1 Corinthians 2:1-5)
 - We all *died* in Christ (substitutionary legal, Romans 5:8, representative - judicial, Romans 5:12, and participatory - Galatians 2:20, Matthew 16:24)
- 2. The *Love* of God sent Christ (In the midst of hostility, conflict, and hate, Malachi 4:5-6, Rom. 5:10)
 - a. The *gift* of our eternal relationship with our Abba Father (groaning Romans 8:15-25)
 - b. The *gift* of the ministry of reconciliation entrusted to us (Colossians 1:28-29)
- 3. The Love of Christ *emboldens* us (Colossians 1:24) (Theology of the Cross)
 - God always *crucifies* before He resurrects in His *power*.
 (A proper theology of the cross leads to a proper theology of the resurrection.)
 - b. The greater the *burden*, the greater the *groaning*, the greater *joy* and divine *power* are found in Christ. (Proverbs 14:10, Matthew 10:25, I Peter 4:1-2, 2 Timothy 3:12)
