- A. This verse is not talking about being baptized for the benefit of someone who has died
- B. It is describing people coming to Christ and being baptized to follow the hope of those who have died

### II. Why make sacrifices for Christ? vv. 30-32

- A. Paul's life was regularly in jeopardy vv. 30-32a
- B. If there is no future, spend life partying v. 32b

# III. Why should we be careful re: friends? vv. 33-34

- A. Now-only minded people can impact us v. 33
- B. An eternal focus should awaken us v. 34
