  - 1. We won't be condemned John 5:24
  - 2. Confidence before the bema seat

## II. A Mature Love Banishes Fear v. 18

- A. This is verse 17 stated in the negative
- B. Obedience is often for our own good
  - 1. John 13:17
  - 2. The Beatitudes

- B. We love others because of God's love
