  - A. Paul calls on God as witness
  - B. Paul wanted to give them time
- II. Paul's Perspective on Leadership v. 24
  - A. Paul was an Apostle
  - B. Yet he did not "lord it over" others (1 Pet. 5:3)
  - C. Paul saw each person's faith as his own
- III. Paul's Desire to Avoid Sorrow 2:1-2
  - A. He didn't want to correct unless necessary
  - B. We ought to be a source of joy for each other
- IV. Paul's Motives in His Previous Letter vv. 3-4
  - A. He didn't want them to corrupt grace Titus 2:11-14
  - B. His goal was to express love, not cause pain
