 - A. Paul resumes his thought in 7:5-12
 - B. Thankful for God's sovereignty
 - C. Thankful for ultimate victory
 - D. Thankful for the privilege of representing Christ
 - 1. We are to God the fragrance of Christ
 - 2. We are to some the fragrance of death
 - 3. We are to some the fragrance of life
 - 4. We are insufficient on our own 3:5
- III. Paul's Integrity with the Word of God v. 17
 - A. He did not peddle or distort the word of God
 - B. He was accurate with it 2nd Timothy 2:15
 - C. He spoke in the sight of God
