 A. He was well-known and respected
 - B. He was chosen by the churches
- III. The Zeal of Paul for Integrity vv. 20-21 A. He took extra precautions
 - B. He was careful before God and men
- IV. The 2nd Brother to Accompany Titus vv. 22-24A. He had a reputation for being diligent
 - B. His life (and the others) was an honor to Christ
 - C. The Corinthians should welcome all of them
