- C. “Slanderers” or “malicious gossips”
- Proverbs 22:1; Ecclesiastes 7:1
- D. “Without self-control”
- E. “Brutal” or savage or fierce or vicious
- F. “Haters of good” or “not lovers of good”

II. The negative character traits of verse 4

- A. “Traitors” or betrayers
- B. Headstrong, rash, or reckless
- C. Haughty or conceited
- D. Lovers of pleasure rather than of God
- Psalm 16:11; Psalm 37:4, 1st Tim. 6:17
