The Various Titles for Elders in the Scripture

They are called "bishops" or "overseers" - Philippians 1:1

They are called "elders" and "bishops" ("overseers") Titus 1:5,7

They are described as elders, bishops, pastors - Acts 20:17, 28 Elder refers to the spiritual maturity of the <u>person</u> Bishop or overseer refers to the <u>office</u> Pastor or shepherd refers to the <u>ministry</u>

The Prominence of Elders in the Book of Acts

They had the responsibility of the oversight of finances 11:27-30

Their appointment was a priority in every church 14:21-23 Paul didn't appoint men to leadership until they were

ready

Some can be ready in a relatively short period of time There were elders (plural) in every church (singular) Their development was a priority in Paul's ministry

They made decisions about the life and doctrine of the church Acts 15:1-6 I Timothy 5:17
