 1. It is synonymous w/ Covenant Theology
 2. Dispensationalism disagrees in 2 areas
 - a. The theology of the church
 - b. The theology of the end times

II. Areas of Theological Study

- A. Bibliology – Inspiration, inerrancy, canonicity, etc.
- B. Theology proper – God’s essence, attributes, trinity, etc.
- C. Christology – His humanity, deity, death, resurrection, etc.
- D. Pneumatology – His personhood, deity, works, etc.
- E. Angelology – Satan, demons, angels, and their works, etc.
- F. Anthropology – Our creation, fall, constitution, etc.
- G. Hamartiology – The fall, our position as sinners, etc.
- H. Soteriology – God’s eternal plan, His call, forgiveness, etc.
- I. Ecclesiology – Birth of the church, ordinance, purpose, etc.
- J. Eschatology – The study of the events of the last days, etc.

III. Differences in Ecclesiology and Eschatology

- A. Ecclesiology
 - Matt. 16:18, 1 Cor. 12:13; 1 Cor10:32; Gal. 6:16
- B. Eschatology
 - Rom. 11:25-29; Matt. 10:28; Dan. 7:13-14; Acts 1:6-7
