I. Paul's Rebuke of Peter v. 11

A. It took place in Antioch

B. It involved inconsistency on Peter's part

II. Peter's Actions vv. 12-13

A. He used to eat with Gentiles

B. When Jews came from James, Peter withdrew

C. His actions implied that you have to keep the law to be accepted by God

D. His actions influenced many others

E. Their actions were hypocritical

III. Paul's Statement v. 14

A. He addressed Peter publicly

B. Peter's action distorted the truth of the gospel
