A. The Law was given through angels

- Deut. 33; Psalm 68; Acts 7; Galatians 3

B. Disobedience to the Law brought punishment

C. Neglecting salvation brings more severe punishment

D. The gospel was confirmed by miracles

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 12:12
