Introduction: Genesis 14:18-20; Psalm 110:4

- Melchizedek, king of righteousness, was without a birth record or genealogical specifics or record of death yet he was the king of Salem (that is king of peace), priest of God Most High, who blessed Abraham and was honored by Abraham when Abram gave him a tithe of the spoils.
 - Melchizedek's priesthood is perpetual

 - D. Levi paid tithes to Melchizedek vv. 9-10
