## I. The Participants of the Story v. 1

- A. Herod the Great
  - 1. He was an Idumean or Edomite
  - 2. He ruled Israel 37 B.C. 4 B.C.
  - 3. He was distrustful, suspicious, brutal

## B. The Wise Men from the East

- 1. Not three kings from the Orient
- 2. They were Babylonian or Persian - Daniel 5:11

## II. The Particulars of the Story vv. 2-12

- A. The inquiry of the King's birth vv. 2-3
- B. The plan of Herod to destroy Jesus vv. 4-8
  1. He asked about Messiah's birthplace
  - 2. He was told it was to be Bethlehem
  - 3. He asked the wise men to inform him
- C. The activity of the wise men vv. 9-12
  - 1. They worshiped the Christ child
  - 2. They returned to their country another way
