Matthew 27:35b-44 (series #160)

Intro: there are a lot of angry people in our world

- I. The Soldiers vv. 35-37
  - A. They divided Jesus' garments & cast lots
  - B. They were enamored w/ material things
  - C. They placed a placard above Jesus' head
- II. The Robbers v. 38
  - A. Jesus was crucified in the center
  - B. He was the worst one by taking our sin
- III. The Onlookers vv. 39-40
  - A. Jesus was crucified in public (John 19:20)
  - B. These people had inaccurate information John 2:19-21
- IV. The Jewish Leaders vv. 41-43
  - A. These were extremely religious people
  - B. They would not have believed regardless
    - 1. John 11:53; 12:10-11
    - 2. Luke 16:27-31
- V. The Robbers (mentioned again) v. 44
  - A. They reviled Jesus
  - B. They wanted Jesus to deliver them

Conclusion: One of the robbers repented - Luke 23:42
