- I. Christ's act had a greater impact than Adam's v. 15
 - A. John 10:10, 11:25, 14:19
 - B. Revelation 1:18, 21:4
- II. God's response to Adam's sin v. 16
 - A. Condemnation to those who are in Adam
 - 1. This shows God's hatred of sin
 - 2. Any sin would be sufficient to damn the race
 - B. Justification to those who are in Christ
 - 1. This shows God's grace and love to the sinner
 - 2. Justification is the opposite of condemnation
- III. The reign of death and the reign of life v. 17
 - A. The reign of death
 - 1. Genesis 5:5,8,11,14,17,27,31
 - 2. Ecclesiastes 1:4, 3:19-20
 - B. The reign of life Revelation 22:5
- IV. Conclusion: the Bible does not teach universalism
 - 1. Matthew 3:7-12, 7:13-27, 8:11-12, 13:40-50, 25:41-46
 - 2. Revelation 20:11-15; 21:7-8,27; 22:14-16
