- Spiritual gifts are not natural abilities
- Gifts are not a sign of spirituality I Cor. 1:7, 11:17
- Gifts are important to understand I Cor. 12:1
- The Holy Spirit is the determiner I Cor. 12:11
- The gifts are for the edification of others
 I Corinthians 14:12. 26
- The gifts and fruit of the Spirit aren't the same
- You can have a gift and not use it

I Timothy 4:14

II Timothy 1:6

- Each gift is a characteristic of Christ
- There may be more gifts than the ones mentioned
