- because it teaches that some things are wrong for some people but not wrong for others

- because of the cultural issues involved

- because it primarily revolved around Jewish Christians

I. Don't cause your brother to fall v. 13

- A. Paul is not talking about people's preferences or dislikes
- B. He is talking about leading someone to violate conscience

II. The example of food v. 14

- A. The Old Testament dietary laws are no longer an issue - Acts 10
- B. But, if your conscience bothers you, it is wrong for you
- III. Walk in love v. 15
- IV. Major on the major issues vv. 16-17
- V. Pursue building up others vv. 18-19 - I Corinthians 8:1
- VI. Don't weaken your brother vv. 20-21

VII. Summary principles: vv. 22-23

- A. Don't flaunt your freedom before the weaker brother
- B. Don't violate your conscience
