- A. We used to use our body parts unrighteously v. 19
- B. This means eyes, ears, tongue, hands, feet, brain, sexual organs

## V. Present yourself to God as a living sacrifice v. 13b

- A. This is a once and for all commitment
- B. This is similar to the command of Romans 12:1

## VI. Present your body parts for righteousness v. 13 c

Conclusion: the basis and reason given in verse 14

- A. sin shall not have dominion over you
- B. you are not under law but under grace
