I. The Response to the Gospel vv. 1-2

- A. This is the gospel Paul had preached in Corinth
- B. This is the gospel the Corinthians had received
- C. This is the gospel by which they were and we are saved
- D. This is the gospel to which true believers hold fast

II. The Reiteration of the Gospel vv. 3-5

- A. Christ died for our sins
 - 1. The Scripture says so
 - 2. He was buried
- B. Christ rose again the 3rd day
 - 1. The Scripture says so
 - 2. He was seen

III. The Reliability of the Gospel vv. 5-8

- A. Jesus was seen by Peter and the twelve v. 5
- B. Jesus was seen by 500 brethren at once v. 6
- C. Jesus was seen by James and other believers v. 7
- D. Jesus was seen by Paul v. 8

Conclusion: there is no reason to doubt bodily resurrection
