Intro: the impossibility of understanding this passage

- I. The Time When Jesus was Judged vv. 33-34**
 - A. There was darkness from noon to 3:00 pm
 - B. Jesus cried out Psalm 22:1
 - C. This was when Jesus died spiritually
 - D. He was relating to God as judge, not Father

- II. The Confusion Surrounding “Eloi” vv. 35-36**
 - A. Someone thought He was calling Elijah
 - B. Others used this to further mock

- III. The Voluntary Death of Jesus v. 37**
 - A. John 10:18
 - B. Luke 19:30

- IV. The Signs at Jesus’ Death vv. 38**
 - A. The veil in the temple was torn top to bottom
- Hebrews 10:19-22
 - B. There was a great earthquake (Matthew)
 - C. There was a partial resurrection (Matthew)

- V. The Response to Jesus’ Death vv. 39-41**
 - A. The centurion and soldiers feared
 - B. They affirmed Jesus as Son of God
 - C. Many women watched from a distance
