Here at Grace, we understand that the corporate gathering on Sunday can be a difficult time to develop relationships characterized by Biblical fellowship, discipleship, and spiritual growth. Thus, small group settings, such as Community Groups, are a pivotally important part of our body life. These groups are designed to be a relational network focused on applying scriptural truths into one another's lives. Each week a set of "homework" questions that encourage the life application of the truth taught in the Sunday sermon will be given in the Sunday bulletin. During each Community Group, homework will be reviewed together leading to open discussion about the realities of the Christian life.

Community Groups are intended to encourage open conversation about the struggles and triumphs being experienced by individual members. These relationships and conversations facilitate the practice of the many scriptural "one anothers," allowing each person in the group to have opportunities to: encourage, exhort, teach, help, bear with, pray for, rebuke and love one another through all the shared life experiences as we encourage one another to grow in Christlikeness.
