Biblical Counseling Ministry

Introduction to Biblical Counseling. A class for real people who talk to real people with real problems and then wonder how to help those real people with those real problems. In this class, we will unpack the philosophy of Biblical Counseling and consider why you can and how you should use God's Word to help real people with their real problems. All believers are welcome and encouraged to be there. Class starts September 9 in Room 802; Sunday mornings at 9:00am.

The following two classes are offered through the Montana Bible College and can be taken as an audit or for credits:

Problems and Procedures in Biblical Counseling. This course is designed to have the students apply the biblical principles taught in the Introduction to Biblical Counseling course to a range of specific counseling problems. Topics include medical aspects i.e., chemical imbalance, depression, anger, abuse, ADD/ADHD, addictions, sleep problems, anxiety, eating problems, decision-making, suffering, accurate view of self, life-dominating sins, and crisis counseling, among others. (Introduction to Biblical Counseling is a prerequisite to this class). Monday and Wednesdays at 8:00am.

The course, **Marriage and Family Counseling**, is designed to help the student take the theory of Biblical Counseling (Introduction to Biblical Counseling) and develop skills in knowing how to accurately and appropriately implement Biblical truths into one's life and then instruct other people in that truth, inspiring and inducing them to implement and integrate that truth into marriage and family relationships. Here at Grace, we understand that the corporate gathering on Sunday can be a difficult time to develop relationships characterized by biblical fellowship, discipleship, and spiritual growth. Thus, everyone is encouraged to be involved in smaller segments of the church body: Community Groups. These groups are designed to be a relational network focused on applying scriptural truths into one another's lives. Each week a set of "homework" questions that encourage the life application of the truth taught in the Sunday sermon will be given in the Sunday bulletin. During each community group, homework will be reviewed together leading to open discussion about the realities of the Christian life.

Community Groups are intended to encourage open conversation about the struggles and triumphs being experienced by individual members. These relationships and conversations facilitate the practice of the many scriptural "one anothers," allowing each person in the group to have opportunities to encourage, exhort, teach, help, bear with, pray for, rebuke and love one another through all the shared life experiences as we encourage one another to grow in Christlikeness.

Frequently Asked Questions

What do Community Groups study?

The majority of Community Groups are sermon-based and work through the Community Group homework provided in the bulletin.

Where do Community Groups meet?

Community Groups meet at homes throughout the Gallatin Valley on various weekday nights. A few men's morning Community Groups meet at Grace Bible Church, see below for more information.

Who are Community Groups for?

Everyone, college-aged and above, who wants to grow in Christlikeness and pursue discipleship relationships. There are over 25 groups church-wide; some for men or women only, some groups provide childcare, one group meets in the afternoon for retired people, and there is even a newlywed group!
