### Welcome to GBC's 2025 Global Outreach Conference!

The theme for this year's conference is Defining and Defending the Word of Christ for the World. Our key verse is Matthew 28:20: "...teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." NKJV

In the words of Dr. Evan Burns, our keynote speaker, "... the word *observe* is more than just *obey* as it is typically rendered. It is a military term that would describe what a sentinel does to quard and defend his post. It is the exact same word used a chapter earlier in Matthew to describe what the soldiers were doing in guarding Jesus (Matthew 27:36, 54). My beef with contemporary discipleship methods is they focus almost completely on telling Christians how to improve their Christian habits and behavior, and very little emphasis is given to training Christians to define and defend what they believe and why they believe it. Rabbinical discipleship was an apprenticeship that trained men to defend the rabbi's doctrine."

The mission we have been given and the message we share, whether crossing the street or crossing the oceans, is this: The Father sent the Son (John 3:16, 20:21) to reconcile sinful man to Himself (Romans 5:1-11). Here we find the doctrines of the Trinity and salvation. The Son sent His disciples and, by extension, the church (Matthew 28:16-20; Luke 24:46-48; Acts 13:1-4; Romans 10:9-17) to proclaim that message of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:17-21). Here are the doctrines of ecclesiology, discipleship, the gospel . . . not to mention the doctrine of obedience. We are to go into the world and make disciples who know Him, who can define what He said, who will defend what He said and demonstrate it by a life that is being daily conformed to the image of Christ.

My prayer is that the Lord will use Dr. Burns, our outreach partners, the seminars, our times of prayer, and the breaking of bread together to stir our hearts to not simply improve our habits and behavior, but to truly carry out the Lord's Commission among all the peoples and nations before us. I hope we can say, "I am better equipped to define and defend what I believe and better equipped to live it and proclaim it to the ends of the earth!" Let's learn together to fulfill the mission of bringing the good news to men, women, and children from every tribe, tongue, and people group, so all peoples and nations will come to faith and worship the Lord!

## DOXA CHURCH BUILDING PROJECT

Doxa Church San Diego is a church plant that Grace has been intimately involved with since their inception in 2023. Pastor Matt Thibault (lead pastor at Doxa) spent his tenure at Grace leading the ministry of CrossLife before following God's call to plant a church outside Montana.

Doxa is a two-year old, 200 person church primarily composed of active duty military personnel and ethnic diversity that matches the city of San Diego. Doxa's vision is to make and multiply disciples, laborers, leaders, and churches in San Diego and beyond for the glory of God. In late 2024, they obtained land and a church building and are now campaigning to build capital for a building project. The next steps involve both an immediate remodel and a new build. Doxa hopes to be on-site in the remodeled space by June 2025—they are actively pursuing fundraising for the new build.

Keynote Speaker / Asia Biblical Theological Seminary
E.D. has been a long-term worker in the Middle East, East Asia, Alaska, and
currently in SE Asia where he serves on faculty at Asia Biblical Theological
Seminary. As a linguist and ordained minister, Burns develops theological
resources and trains indigenous pastors and workers to the least-reached.
